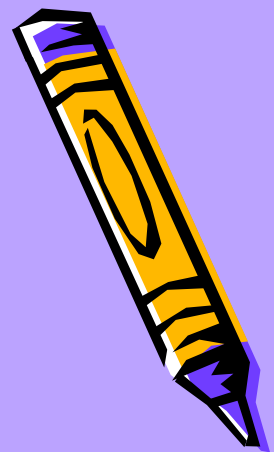

# Our Expectations

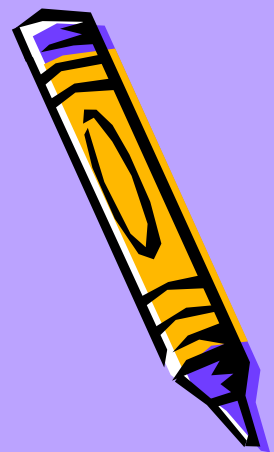


- Please ensure that your child's book bag is in school every day with their **reading book, reading record** and any **homework**

- Attendance & Punctuality



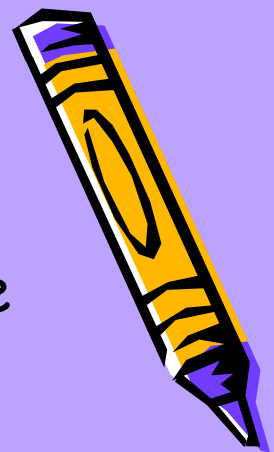
# Reading

- Asking questions throughout reading, developing comprehension skills.



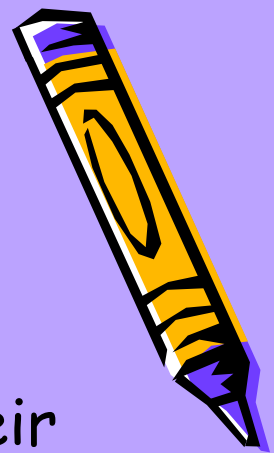
# Homework

- Spellings - children will receive their spellings on a **Tuesday** and will be tested on the following **Monday**.

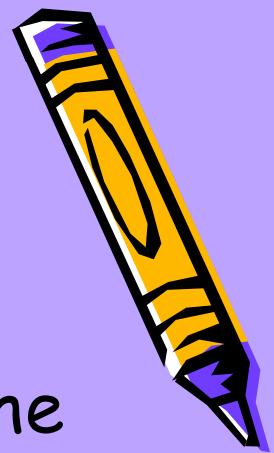


# Independence

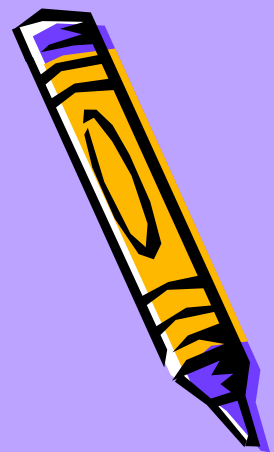

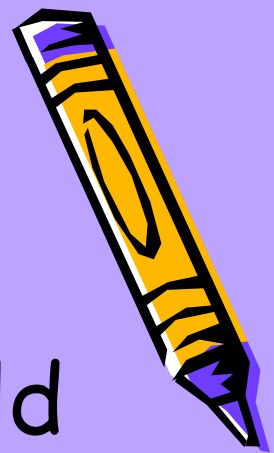

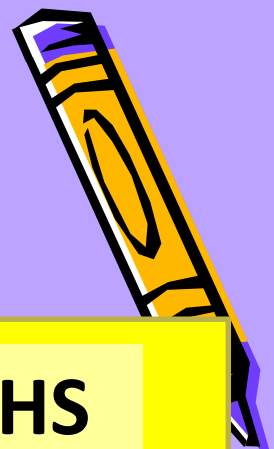
