Our **Lego Challenge** will be released every Wednesday, and task your children to complete an imaginative Lego project, based on a different theme each week.

Code Club will take place on Thursdays and feature a range of STEM-based coding projects.

We're still in the early stages of developing the Kids' Club, and we have lots of exciting plans for it, so please keep checking back to see what we've added.
