







The Results



The results are in! MVE 2020 was a competitive one. A total of 3,887 schools, 31,039 classes, 433,924 pupils took part and answered a total of 441.93 million questions answered correctly.

Out of 3,887 schools we came 19th in our total school score and 167th in our pupil average score. Our top classes: Year 6 Zaha Hadid & Year 4 Marie Curie came 83rd & 121st respectively out of over 30,000 classes. That is phenomenal!
