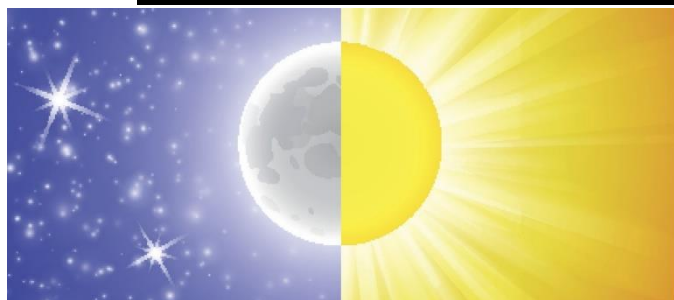


Nursery Knowledge Organiser - Night and Day
