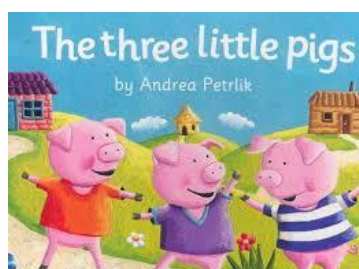
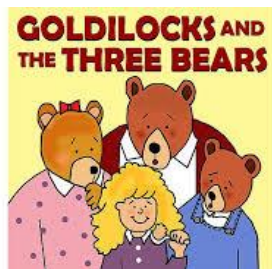


Nursery Knowledge Organiser – Traditional Tales

<p>How do most traditional tales start?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Develop speaking and listening skills through stories - "Goldilocks and the Three bears; The Three Little Pigs; The Three Billy Goats Gruff; The Gingerbread Man" Retell / re-enact stories using puppets/props Join in with repeated phrases from stories such as "I'll huff, I'll puff, I'll blow your house down"; Run, run , as fast as you can, you can't catch me, I'm the Gingerbread man". <p>Can I name some of the characters in the story?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Through stories talk about feelings such as sad, upset, cross, angry Learn that it is normal to have such feelings Show care and concern for each other Express likes and dislikes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Where is the story set? What happened in the story? How do traditional tales end? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sing songs - "When Goldilocks went to the house of the bears"; "Who's afraid of the Big Bad Wolf?" 	<p>Once upon a time Lived Bears Cottage woods Big, medium, small Porridge Three Little pigs Build House Sticks Straw Bricks Blow Big Bad wolf Huff, puff Gingerbread Man Woman Cow, horse, farmer fox Bake oven Run Fast Catch Run away Happy, sad, upset, Mean Unkind Happily, ever after end</p>
