Attendance

- Every day is important.
- Incentives for good attendance e.g. non-uniform days; certificates for 100% attendance.

- Holidays in term time will not be authorised.
- Daily password system in place. If anyone other than yourself is collecting your child at the end of the school day they will require a password. You can attain this from the school office.

Uniform

Uniform is compulsory.

How to support your child at home

- To be able to hold a pencil correctly using a tripod grip
- To be able to cut holding scissors correctly
- To be able to recognise and write their name (not in capital letters)
- To begin to learn the letter names and sounds,
- To form some letters from the alphabet correctly
- To be able to count to 20
- To begin to recognise and form numbers up to 20
- To recognise and name some/all 2D shapes
- Share a book and talk about the story with your child
