- **Key focus- Comprehension** (to talk in detail and answer questions related to text)
- Story maps
- Predicting text
- Talk for reading (retelling the story in their own words)
- Looking at a structure of a story (beginning, middle and end).
- Descriptive writing
- Writing stories
- Alliteration and rhyming words

Maths

- Money- 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coin values
- Subtraction up to 20
- Addition up to 20
- 1 more/1 less than any given number.
- Weighing (using language heavy, light, lightest)
- Counting in 2s
- Time- vocabulary such as first next, then, after, o'clock
