This term we will be:

 - *Role play to familiarise ourselves with a new story.*

- 5. *Write the beginning, middle and end of a story.*
- Be developing our use of adjectives and conjunction (e.g. and/because) to expand our sentences.

Maths:

This term we will:

- Count forwards and backwards, fluently, to and from 100
- Count, read and write numbers to 100
- Practise reading, writing and ordering numbers from 0 to 20 (digits and words)
- Practise a quick recall of number bonds to 20
- Solve subtraction word problems
- Find quarter of shapes and quantities
- Through practical activities, learn the mathematical vocabulary for length, height (e.g. short/ shorter/ shortest), capacity (full/empty), mass or weight (heavy and light)

Music

We will learn what rhythm is and create our own rhythms. We will also try to replicate the sounds of dinosaurs using a range of musical instruments.
