

The Humber Bridge

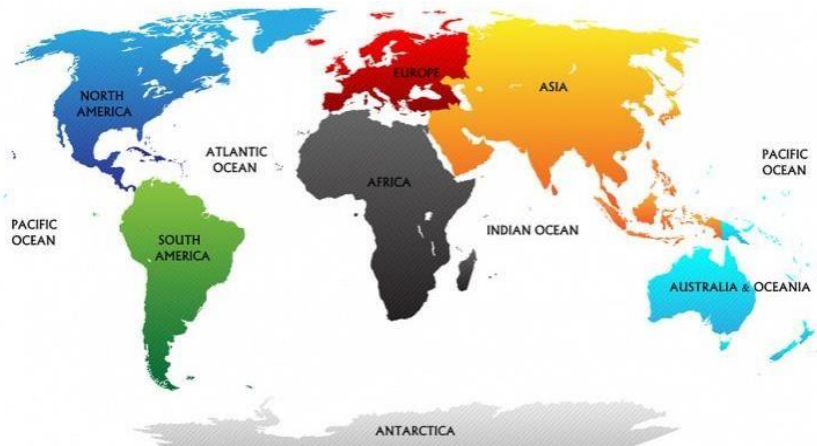
- One of the top 10 largest suspension bridges in the world.
